Update from the Course Organisers

- Distribution of GP registrars was discussed – it is possible we may have one or two from the Chelmsford scheme
- There was discussion of registrar placements and F2 placements – some of the F2 doctors are reliant on public transport so attachment in Harwich or Clacton can be a problem for them
- There was discussion about the recent ETD problems with the registrars – it was not clear if they were including private study time or travel to work time in the work hours recorded
- Discussed assessments for FY2 and access to their eportfolios – the latest version seems to require access via a ‘ticket number’ obtained by the FY2

CbD benchmarking was then discussed led by Dr Steve Porter

- ‘Talking the Talk’ a dvd from the college is available and contains several CbD with discussion on the grading and marking scheme was mentioned.
- Then a video of a recent assessment was shown and discussed.
- Discussion centred on how a CBD should be approached – one of the issues is about how much is a presentation and how much is probing questions; CbD is supposed to be a review what they did rather than what they should have done.
- The Bradford VTS web site was mentioned as a good source of possible questions
- COT and CBD mapping was discussed – again there is good resource on the Bradford VTS site
